

*Announcing: **The Zonta District 10 STEM Scholarship**
(\$1000 scholarship to be awarded to one qualified recipient through the
Zonta District 10 Foundation)*

Zonta International is a leading global organization of professionals empowering women worldwide through service and advocacy.

District 10 is a part of Zonta International, and is comprised of four states: Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma and Texas.

The goal of the STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) Scholarship is to encourage more young women to pursue a higher education degree in science, technology, engineering or math, while also encouraging leadership achievements in science, technology, engineering and/or math and a dedication to the advancement of the status of women.

Who is Eligible?

Currently enrolled undergraduate female students living in or attending college within the District 10 geographical boundaries at the time of the application and who demonstrate evidence of the following:

- Enrollment in a STEM (science, technology, engineering, math) curriculum at an accredited college or university (including community college), **having earned no less than 30 college hours**
- Permanent residence in one of the following states: Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, or Texas OR a state of a member of Zonta club of USA-2.
- U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- Strong high school academic preparation for study in a STEM-related field
- Strong Academic Achievement (3.00 CGPA on a 4.00 scale)

Application Requirements

- Completion of the official application
- Receipt of official college transcript
- Receipt of official high school transcript
- Official verification of current enrollment in a STEM program (if not verified on the official transcript)
- Two confidential recommendations from adults, not related to the applicant, such as teachers, school officials or community leaders.
